Lent begins this Wednesday, February 22 with 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Mass and the distribution of ashes at St. Joseph, and 6:00 p.m. at St. Peter. Fast and abstinence are two common penances in the Church observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence means that we do not eat meat and is observed each Friday of Lent by those ages 14 and over. Fasting means that we eat only one full meal, two other light meals, and no eating between meals. This applies to those ages 18-59 with the exception for pregnant women and people who are sick. Several prayer and formation opportunities are offered during Lent to enrich your spiritual journey:

1. Weekly on Tuesdays, 7-8:30 p.m. "Journey into Light", a scripture study based on the Sunday lectionary gospels.
2. Fridays of Lent, 7 p.m., Stations of the Cross (rotating through each parish weekly). A variety of station prayers, focusing on aspects of lament, peace, justice will provide the meditations. Feb. 24 - St. Joseph "Gateway to Resurrection" Way of the Cross, dramatization by the Benedictine Spirituality group .
3. Saturdays following 5:30 Mass-"The LENTil Soup Series." This begins Feb. 25 and will cover a variety of topics in a casual conversation, while enjoying delicious homemade soups & desserts. The Liturgy and the four pillars of the church (Creed, Scripture, Sacraments, and Prayer) will provide the basis for these conversations. Time: approximately 6:30-8:00.
